

Instructions:

Print the following cues/prompts on heavy card stock paper. After printing, cut along the framed edges to make individual cards.

In pairs, one student (S1) has question cards, the other partner (S2) has one “use to” and one “used to” card.

The student with the question cards (S1) holds them so the partner student (S2) cannot see them, and reads the first question to S2.

S2 must answer each question with a “Yes” **and** “No” response sentence using the correct form of “use to” or “used to” while holding up the correct card used in the response statement to help S1 distinguish which form is being spoken.

For example:

S1 reads, “Did you use to exercise daily?”

S2 first responds with a positive statement, “Yes, I used to exercise daily” while holding up the card that says “used **d** to”.

Then, S2 gives a negative response, “No, I didn’t use to exercise daily” while holding up the card that says “use to”.

S1 then reads the next question, and the process repeats.

This alternation of question with positive and negative responses continues until all questions have been asked.

Ss then exchange cards, and repeat the process, i.e., S1 now has the response cards and S2 now has the question cards.
